16. The meeting was adjourned for the lunch break. During the break, Mr. Carl Lawson delivered a keynote address in which he described, from the perspective of a person involved from the beginning the development and evolution of the commissioning process and movement. He shared actual experiences from his work at Duke University and offered insights from their successful program.

Following the lunch break, Emory University offered tours of two facilities, the Schwartz Center for the Performing Arts, nearing completion which is heavily involved in the commissioning process, and Whitehead Laboratories, a completed facility that benefited significantly from the commissioning process and which attained LEED certification.
18. There being no further business of the Chapter, Mr. Smith adjourned the meeting at the completion of the tours, with the invitation to meet at the next meeting in Alabama. He offered the hospitality of Emory University for those who wished to meet and socialize following the close of the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 3:45 PM.
